



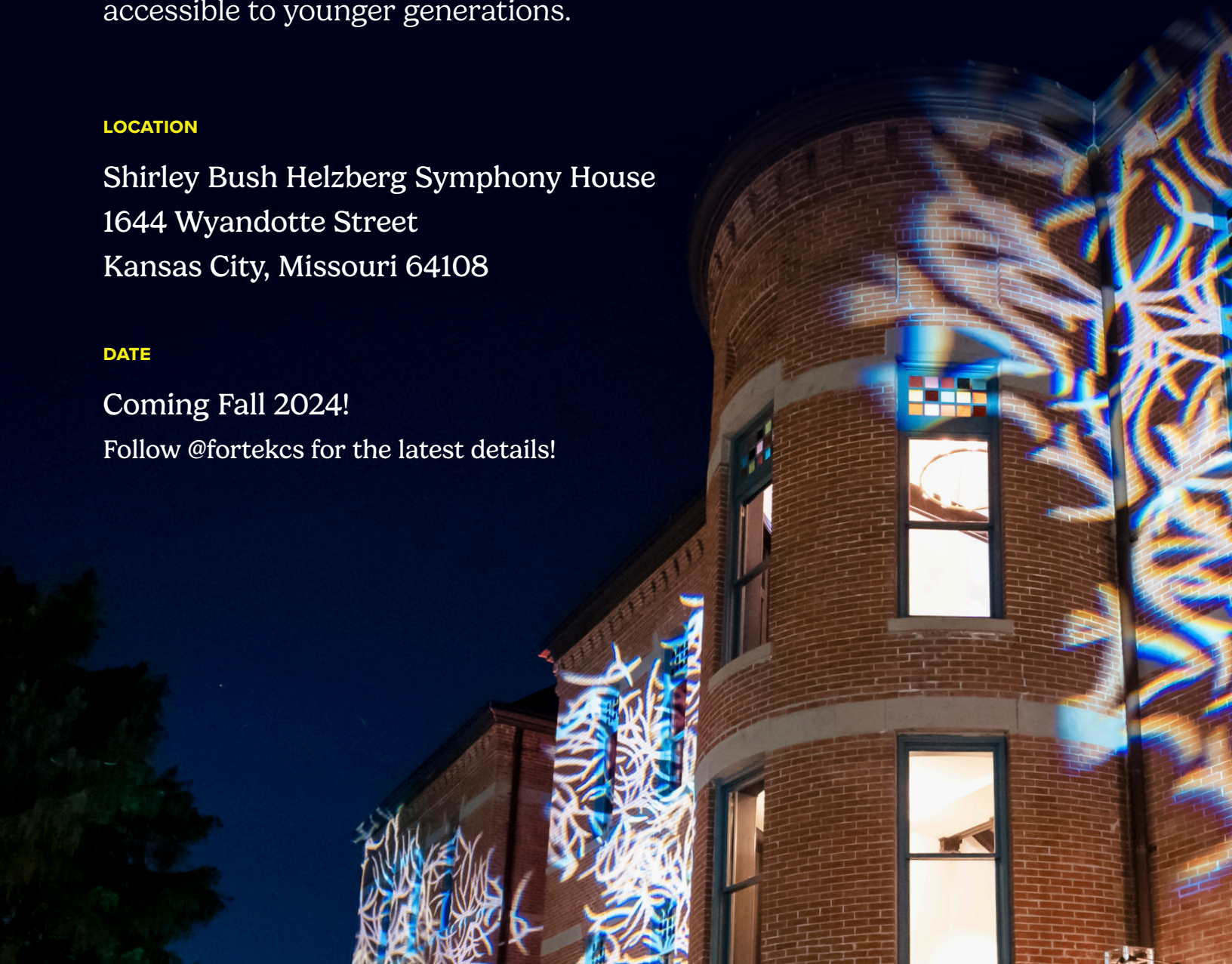

The Kansas City Symphony is the youngest major symphony orchestra in the United States and one of the most secure. Since its founding in 1982 by R. Crosby Kemper, Jr., the Kansas City Symphony has grown through artistic vision, fiscal discipline, and a culture of trust and excellence in all facets of the organization. The orchestra's 80 full-time musicians contribute to the city's robust cultural community. During its 42-week season, the Symphony performs a wide variety of concerts, including subscription classical, pops and family, film with orchestra, and educational programs.

The Symphony has deep roots in serving its local community, traveling throughout Kansas City with its mobile stage known as the Mobile Music Box. The vision of the Symphony's educational program is to enable people of all ages in the greater Kansas City area to learn, create, and become inspired through orchestral music. More than 60,000 people participate in Kansas City Symphony education programs annually.
